# *From Fr. Simon*



During the baptism of infants there is a part of the rite called the “*Ephphatha*,” where the minister of baptism touches the baby's ears and mouth, saying: “The Lord Jesus made the deaf hear and the dumb speak. May he soon touch your ears to receive his word, and your mouth to proclaim his faith, to the praise and glory of God the Father.” In today’s Gospel story of the healing of the deaf mute, we are reminded of the connection between hearing and speech. Only after the deaf man is able to listen can he learn to speak.

In the last couple of months, it has become clear that our Church continues to have a listening problem. We have been reminded of the repulsive actions which were committed against innocent children and the failure of people in charge, especially bishops, to hear accusers, to act on those allegations and to remove those who were predators from access to potential victims. This has left me, and the members of the Church, hurt and angry. Trust was betrayed, responsibility ignored, selfish interest trumped values and transparency jettisoned for secrecy. We must be vigilant to ensure decisive actions of justice and compassion for victims and that the consequences of the law be applied to predators at this moment and in the future.

I want to assure you dear people of Queen of All Saints that creating a safe environment of trust in which our children can learn and grow is of paramount importance to me and the priests of the parish. A recent audit from the Office of Children and Youth confirms that we continue to be in full compliance of all safety guidelines and regulations set by the Archdiocese of Chicago and Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) protocol. I want you to know that as your pastor, I am open to hear your concerns and to explore ways to better serve and protect our children.

While it is true, that the body of Christ, our Church, is infected with abuse and deceit, the John Jay study (see below) has shown that four to six percent of the priests were part of the problem. It is important to note that the number of priests and bishops, nuns and religious who want to be part of the solution is much bigger. The more we look at the Church the more we will realize its imperfections. Let us look a little more at Christ and one another, celebrate the relationships we have forged within this community called ‘church’, support one another through these difficult times and pray and support our priests and bishops so that we no longer are deaf to the cries of the victims and to be their voice for justice and compassion.

**San Lorenzo Ruiz** was born in 1600 in Binondo, Manila to a Chinese father and Filipino mother who were both Catholic. He was an altar boy growing up and was educated by Dominican Fathers. He was a member of the Confraternity of the Rosary. Ruiz was a husband and father to a daughter and two sons.

He left the Philippines in 1636 and moved to Japan where he suffered terrible persecution and was cruelly tortured and martyred. Despite the severe torture he endured he never lost his faith. Ruiz died on September 27, 1637.

Lorenzo Ruiz was beatified by Pope John Paul II during a Papal visit to Manila on February 18 1981. Ruiz was later canonized in Rome on World Mission Sunday October 18, 1987. St. Lorenzo Ruiz is the first Filipino Saint venerated in the Roman Catholic Church.



## Our Financial To-Do List

### Capital Campaign.

### Our Basilica Repair Work Continues

- We began repairs of water damage around the transept windows during the summer, to include replacing the caulk around the storm windows as well as repairs to some of the support rods holding the stained glass windows in place. **We also took the opportunity to clean the stained glass windows before reinstallation. We hope you can see the difference when we removed 60 years of grime!** The windows along the side aisles will also require some repairs, which will be scheduled over the next few years.
- The deteriorated marble behind the side altars has been removed and will be replaced with a modern lightweight replacement material similar to what was used in the sanctuary behind the main altar a few years ago. Currently there is a temporary substitute in place until all exterior stone work is completed.
- **Our biggest current project will be to make masonry repairs to the bell tower, which will begin later this year.**

## The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

## The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

## Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
