## FROM FATHER SIMON

---



The last Sunday of the Liturgical Year celebrates the Feast of Christ the King. Following World War I and amidst the rise of various totalitarian movements and dictatorships in Europe, Pope Pius XI established the Feast of Christ the King with his encyclical *Quas Primas* (1925). The Holy Father was concerned that the current era was one that was increasingly characterized by secularism, xenophobia and imperialism.

Pope Pius hoped that the annual feast would remind the Church and the wider world that there were belief systems, ethical standards and obligations that transcend narrow nationalistic ambitions. These principles, expressed clearly in the life and teachings of Jesus Christ, suggest that there were better ways to exercise authority in the political, social and cultural spheres.

Pope Pius championed the principles of religious tolerance, justice, non-violence and diplomacy as the means to achieve peace and security for all nations under Christ. He also hoped that the members of the Church would gain strength and courage from the celebration of the feast, and be reminded that Christ must reign in our hearts, minds, wills, and bodies if we are to achieve genuine concord between individuals and nations.

Why do we celebrate different seasons in the church? Why not treat every Sunday, and every time of the year the same? Well, first of all, I think it would get a little monotonous, maybe even boring. Just like we observe different days and times in our ‘regular’ year, like birthdays and anniversaries, times to work and times to recreate, we focus on different aspects of our faith and our life as a community during the church year.

One could say the church year reflects the circle of life with all its ups and downs, all things ordinary and extraordinary. ‘For everything there is a season’, it says in the book of Ecclesiastes - and it seems good and important to give each thing in our life its proper time and space.

Throughout the entire church year we hear how Christ is King - from the longing hymns in Advent to the joyous Christmas carols we sing to the Easter anthems - Christ is King, all the days of the church year, all the days of our lives. In that sense, Christ the King Sunday, being celebrated at the end of our church year ties the entire year together and reminds us that Christ rules our lives, and we are called to abandon all the idols we worship, and follow Christ alone.



## The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

## The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

## Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
