## FROM FATHER SIMON

---



The Lake of Galilee is shaped like a harp and is sometimes called the Lake of Gennesaret or Kinneret, from the Hebrew word for “harp”. The lake is sometimes called the Sea of Galilee. The Lake (the Sea) of Galilee is the only natural freshwater lake in Israel and is so essential to the life of the people of Israel that its levels are mentioned in the daily newspapers. Capernaum, Tiberias and Magdala are towns that dot the shores of the Lake of Galilee.

To these waters people came to quench their thirst and from these waters fishermen brought home or to the market, fish - that sustained life for the people around this lake. It was around this body of water that most often people gathered to listen to Jesus. It was around this water that Jesus called his first few disciples. It was on the Sea of Galilee that an experienced fisherman, Peter, took the advice of a carpenter and lowered his nets to haul in a catch that surprised him.

This miraculous catch caused the new disciple Peter to fall to his knees and confess ‘Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man’. Peter knelt in humility, in awe of the mighty act of God. Humbled, he is exalted and called to be a ‘fisher of men’.

In the current climate of the Church, the words of Peter ‘Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man,’ must for the Pope, bishops and priests be not only a prayer of humility but more importantly a prayer of sorrow and penitence for the crimes of sexual abuse against children and others. As Church, we are hurting and angry and we want something to be done.

So, I invite you to share your concerns and feelings on the recent clergy sexual abuse scandal, and your thoughts on how our Church community can protect and assist abuse survivors, protect against future victimization and increase transparency and accountability as we move forward. A ‘Listening Session’ will take place on Wednesday, February 13th at 6:30 p.m. in the school cafeteria.

It was not once that Peter was humbled. He was humbled again by the recognition of his denial of Jesus in the face of adversity. Yet Jesus calls him again to feed and tend his sheep. Yes, we do love our Church, the body of Christ, and we will continue to pray and work to ensure responsible, accountable and transparent leadership now and into the future.





## The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

## The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

## Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
