

# FROM FATHER SIMON



Happy Mother's Day! Every culture and nation honors mothers in a unique way. It is because we know instinctively the gift of a mother. It is she who carried us in her womb, the first home, before we were offered to our family or to the world.

I recognize that this role of "mom" does not need to fit a strict definition of 'woman who birthed me'. When I think of my mother, I remember her nurturing, the sacrifices she made, the generosity of her time, her patience, her resilience, her compassion for the poor and the sick, her determination to learn a new language and adapt to a different culture, and above all, her faith. She loved me and expressed it in different ways, for which I'm grateful, because it showed me that love comes in many forms, taking shape according to the persons expressing and receiving it.

This Mother's Day honor and remember all the relationships we have with the women in our lives who are important to us, both young and old, alive and passed. We can choose to reflect upon and celebrate mothers, stepmothers, grandmothers, aunts, sisters, wives, girlfriends, friends, colleagues, mentors, daughters, nieces and granddaughters.

This past Friday, the Most Reverend Bishop Mark Bartosic, an auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Chicago, administered the Sacrament of Confirmation to ninety-four eighth graders of our parish. With the reception of this sacrament, these young people, along with Baptism and Holy Eucharist they received earlier, complete the Sacraments of Initiation. In preparation to receive this sacrament, the students put in service hours, were instructed in the faith by our dedicated teachers and catechists, attended a retreat and wrote letters to the pastor indicating their desire and reasons to be confirmed. Allow me to share with you their own words about the sacrament...

Isabel - *"Being Catholic has helped me become the best version of myself."*

Michael - *". . . strengthen my relationship with God, become complete and active member of the Catholic Church."*

Claire - *"I chose St. Valentine because it is very important to love and accept everybody for who they are."*

Kate - *"we are called to be servants to one another."*

Congratulations! May the Spirit enable and empower you to live as fully initiated members of the Catholic Church, and as children of God extend the message of Christ's love to the world.



## The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

## The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

## Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
