# THE STORY OF OUR PARISH'S PLAN FOR THE FUTURE OUR CAPITAL CAMPAIGN FROM GENERATION TO GENERATION

## **History of the Benedict Center**

Our Benedict Center was originally designed and constructed in 1953 as the convent for the Benedictine Sisters who taught at our school for 50 years, originally with room to house 28 nuns. After years of dedicated service the Benedictines left the convent in 1993. The building was then partially converted to our new parish preschool in 1994, a use which has continued to today.

## **Our Initial Challenges**

Since it was built as a residence for nuns the Benedict Center had relatively little useable space for other parish activities. By the early 2010's we had a building with increasing repair and maintenance costs, but with relatively little overall benefit to the parish at a 20% occupancy. At the same time, our needs for more space for our early childhood education program and for our various adult ministries was increasing, as well as a long-delayed need to address space needs within our Keene and Lemont buildings.

## **Our Vision for the Future**

*Our general consensus then was to reallocate and upgrade space within our existing buildings, on a highly cost-effective basis especially when compared with new construction, allowing us to wisely steward the gifts of our parish community.*

*Our Plan Is Based on Wide Consultation, Careful Planning and Continuous Oversight*

**2014** - We begin to consider various parish space needs as well as proposals to finance those needs

**2015** - We begin a formal process to consult with major parish ministries to list possible capital projects and to assign priorities to those projects

**2015** - We retain architect's to prepare preliminary designs for the renovation of the Benedict Center, which had been determined as the highest priority need. These design proposals are reviewed by major parish ministries

**2016** - Draft 4 of the architect's proposal is unveiled at an all-parish town hall meeting and again reviewed by school staff and parish ministries

- Unanimous approval of the plan by the parish Finance Council
- Fundraising drive is designed, and begins July 1. Cash collection of pledges begins

**2018** - General contractor is retained, Fr. Simon presides over a blessing for those who have contributed their time and financial resources to our project, construction begins in Benedict Center

**2019** - On June 20 we received our occupancy permit for the newly renovated Benedict Center, and begin work on the Lemont and Keene buildings, Phase II of our capital campaign

**2020** - We begin work on Phase III of the Lemont Building

## ***Where are we today?***

*We rejoice in the success of our campaign to date, and give our deepest thanks to those who have helped us arrive at the completion of Phase I of our campaign and the beginning of Phases II and III. We also face the difficult truth that unforeseen construction issues such as hidden asbestos and the need to replace more of the old buildings, such as the Benedict Center windows, has forced us to increase our fund-raising target from \$5 million to \$6 million, \$200,000 of which has already been raised.*

***As we pause for a moment to enjoy our achievement we then immediately turn to our next needs:***

- *To maintain and even accelerate the collection of our pledges to complete Phases II and III*
- *To ask those whose circumstances have changed over the last few years to consider increasing their pledges*
- *To ask those may have paused before making their initial pledge to step up now and join the over 800 households who have contributed to the most important project in our parish in the last generation.*

# STATUS OF OUR CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

We have almost completed the construction of Phase 1 of our capital campaign, the near total rebuilding of the Benedict Center. After the open house on July 7th, and for the remainder of the summer, we will be moving back in. This will complete the transformation of that space from a 20% use of a long-neglected building to a 100% use of state-of-the-art early childhood education classrooms and an assortment of comfortable meeting spaces for our growing adult ministries.

*This is a dream come true for a parish that values its children. It is also a necessity for a parish with so many adults who wish a deeper involvement in learning about their faith and in living their faith.*

But as we catch our breath at the completion of Phase 1 we immediately pivot to Phases 2 and 3, the renovation of space in our Lemont and Keene Avenue buildings for use by our school, renovating the former kindergarten space into the largest new space for our adult ministries, and finally concluding with the restoration of the former Rose Room in the basement of the Lemont building to its original purpose – a parish hall!



All of this comes, of course, at a price. Anyone who has gone through a home renovation knows the expense that comes with progress, even with good planning and careful oversight. Our project is certainly no exception, and we also have the extra cost of building for long-term and very heavy use, plus the cost of unexpected construction surprises inherent in older buildings.



**But right now I have two urgent requests.**

First, as we have already noted very often in our progress reports in the bulletin and elsewhere, the final cost of all our needed improvements will be at least \$6 million. We have received pledges of direct donations to our parish of roughly \$5.2 million. **We have collected 61% of those pledges to date**, but the pace of collections has slowed due in large part to the multi-year nature of those pledges. We always keep a close eye on our ultimate costs and the most cost-effective way to complete our dreams is to continue our pace of construction and that will require

us to accelerate our pace of pledge collections. **Please make every effort to stay current on your donation to our parish and even perhaps to complete your donation early. There may also be some tax advantages under the new tax reform laws to accelerate the total payment of your donation this year in 2019.**

Second, as we noted above, there is still a gap between donations to the parish and our final cost. Our fundraising effort remains open to those whose circumstances may have improved since their initial pledge or who may feel more confident in making an initial pledge or increasing their earlier pledge. **If you are able, please stretch your commitment to our parish's future by making or increasing your direct donation to our parish.** All of us have benefitted from the efforts of others, from both the distant past and from the more recent past. **It is time for all of us to stand as one as we strengthen our parish for the bright and hopeful future we all share.**



## Stewardship: Direct Contributions From Your IRA

If you are 70 and a half, or older, and have an IRA, you may qualify for a charitable giving opportunity directly from your IRA.

- You are now allowed to make direct transfers from an IRA to Queen of All Saints tax-free, even if you don't itemize.
- You can transfer up to \$100,000 annually.
- The transfer can also be credited against your required annual minimum distribution if you have not yet taken it.

The tax-free nature of this withdrawal may have a number of other favorable benefits affecting your tax return, depending on your particular situation, such as reduced taxes on Social Security distributions or future Medicare premiums.

## The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

## The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

## Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
