# FROM FATHER SIMON



Thank you, dear people of Queen of All Saints! Through your generosity this past weekend, over 400 children, parents and caretakers will have smiles on their faces and gratitude in their hearts as they open their Christmas gifts. In a special way I want to thank the members of our St. Vincent de Paul Society for their tireless work to help us ‘Share Christmas’ with those in need. They procure the lists, make sure they are on the tree for us to pick up, sort out the gifts with the help of student volunteers and ensure they are delivered to parishes and organizations. Thank you for bringing joy to children and families.

‘JOY’ – that is the theme for the Third Sunday of Advent. This Sunday is called ‘Gaudete Sunday’. The opening antiphon for today’s liturgy asks us to “*Gaudete in Domino semper*” - “Rejoice in the Lord always”. Today, on our Advent wreath we light our pink candle to mark this day of joy because as the antiphon tells us ‘*The Lord is very near*’.

The Lord is very near indeed as we join the Filipino American Community Association of Queen of All Saints Basilica (FACA) to mark the 31<sup>st</sup> year of celebrating Simbang Gabi at our parish. “Misa de Gallo” or Simbang Gabi is a longstanding Filipino religious tradition dating back to the late 16th century that is celebrated during the season of Advent in preparation for the coming of Jesus on Christmas. The missionary friars at that time held nine days of Masses to usher in the event of Christ’s birth, and this tradition continues to the present. Traditionally, these Masses are celebrated in the early morning hours, typically at 4 a.m. when the roosters crow to announce the coming of a new day. Hence, it is called Misa de Gallo (“Gallo” means rooster).

The missionary friars designed this structure of celebrating the Mass in the early morning to meet the needs of the people, most of whom were farmers. In this way, the farmers could attend Mass and ask blessings from God before they headed out to work, so that their work would bring about more harvest. In this way, the missionary friars could implant the Catholic faith in the hearts and minds of the Filipino people and continue to spread the gospel by integrating it into a distinctly Filipino custom. Here in the United States, these Masses are celebrated in the evening to accommodate work schedules and make the celebration more accessible to families. Hence, the name is changed from Misa de Gallo into Simbang Gabi which simply means “Night Mass”.

The experience of rising early in the morning and traveling to church in the dark adds an element of sacrifice to this season of preparation. I invite you to join our parish celebration of Simbang Gabi Mass on Saturday, December 21 at 7 p.m. Afterward, continue the celebration by joining everyone in the gym to enjoy Filipino culture, food and hospitality. I look forward to seeing you there!

The Archdiocesan Council of Catholic Women (ACCW) offers a \$1,000 scholarship renewable for four years to the deserving young Catholic woman who can successfully articulate what it means to be a Catholic woman in the world today.

The applicant should currently be a high school senior. She does not have to attend a Catholic high school, nor does she have to select a Catholic college or university. # SCHOOL NEWS



Dear Parishioner,

Queen of All Saints School is grateful to you for supporting the advancement of Catholic school education. I am writing about a unique opportunity for Archdiocese of Chicago Catholic schools. The State of Illinois created a tax credit scholarship program through the “Invest in Kids” Act that is mutually beneficial to students and donors. It provides a 75 percent Illinois State income tax credit to individuals who contribute money to fund scholarships for students to attend private schools. Eligible students from low-income families in Illinois may use these scholarships to attend a non-public school of their choice, including the more than 200 Archdiocese of Chicago Catholic schools in Cook and Lake Counties.

To increase the funds available for scholarships next year, several donors have partnered with the scholarship granting organization Empower Illinois and the Archdiocese of Chicago to create a matching gift pool.

- Every dollar donated to this program through Empower Illinois between Dec. 1, 2019 and Feb. 29, 2020 and designated to a school operated by the Archdiocese of Chicago will be matched with two dollars from this pool (limitations apply). The program will end when all matching funds have been depleted or on Feb. 29, 2020, whichever comes first.
- A \$5,000 donation will have a tremendous impact. With the 75 percent tax credit you receive on the donation and this match, it will have a net cost to you of \$1,250 and will provide \$15,000 in scholarships for low-income families.
- After April 1, 2020, any matching gift program funds that are not awarded at a designated school will be reallocated to low-income students at schools with unmet demand.
- Donors who would like to receive the tax credit for their 2019 taxes should begin the process prior to Dec. 16, 2019 to ensure they have enough time to make their gift by Dec. 31, 2019.

## Reason to Rejoice

Dark violet is used throughout Advent to express its character as a season of spiritual preparation for Christmas and “the coming of the Lord.” But on the Third Sunday of Advent, formerly known as *Gaudete* (Latin for “rejoice”) Sunday, rose may be added to the liturgical environment. The entire liturgy is infused with a spirit of rejoicing.

Today’s first reading and Gospel proclaim the reality of God’s saving work in our midst. Isaiah exuberantly describes the idyllic transformation of all creation as a result of God’s presence in the midst of the people. In the Gospel, Jesus connects Isaiah’s prophecy with what is happening in his own ministry. In addition to the list of healings from Isaiah (the blind, the lame, lepers, and the deaf), Jesus’ presence brings two other reasons for rejoicing: “The dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them” (Matthew 11:5).

## The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

## The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

## Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
