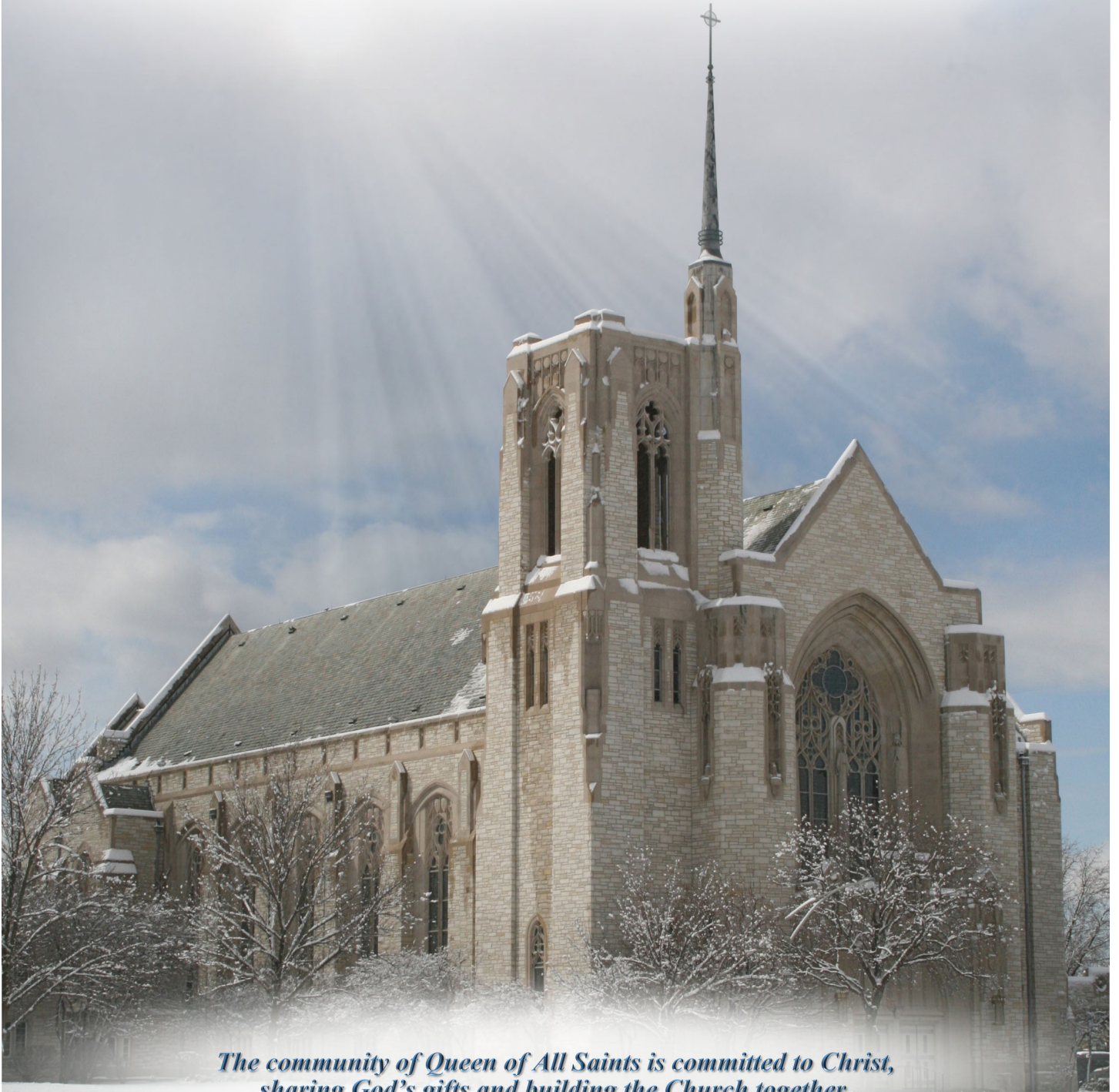

FROM FATHER SIMON



I spent Christmas Eve with one family and Christmas Day with another. Between these two meals, I ‘face-timed’ my siblings and their families in India. Having spent Christmas with these families, two beautiful experiences stand out for me – hospitality and goodness – both striking qualities of Jesus’ life and mission. Both families were genuinely welcoming and made a space for me to feel part of their gathering. They not only shared their food, they also shared what is most precious to them – their lives and the joys and struggles of their hearts. Both families were also deeply appreciative of the goodness of each other. They were full of gratitude in recognition of the true blessing and gift each one is for the other.

Christmas is really a family story, and we know there’s no substitute for the gifts that family provides. When we gaze at the crib, we might think that our family doesn’t look much like the Holy Family. There is too much hustle and bustle, pain, busyness, confusion and mess in our families.

But let’s stop right there for a moment and put the Holy Family in context. Today’s Gospel should focus our thoughts more clearly. Perhaps we tend to polish up the manger, making it a bit unreal? “Little Lord Jesus, no crying he makes” isn’t how it really was. This was a family that knew real struggle. Today St. Matthew shows us that theirs was a story of homelessness, poverty, exile, the threat of violence, hopefully problems that we’ll never need to deal with. In the eyes of the world, they were without status, a family trying to escape the unfairness of life.

The struggles that came along, however, never quenched their incredible love for God and for one another. This was what made them “holy.” Paul’s letter to the Colossians shows us where holiness can be found within our own families. Sometimes the pressures of life will be intense. But when we make the effort to put aside our busyness to celebrate with our loved ones, we can be sure that God is there with us. When we show forgiveness and forbearance, letting go of our hurts, we come to understand a little more of the mystery of God in our world. We remember gratefully those times when someone in our family let us know that we were cherished. In all these ways we grow in awareness of God’s great love for us.

So today, on the Feast of the Holy Family, let’s cherish each other’s presence while we can still be together. Can we make sure that respect, love and care never go out of fashion in our families and resolve that we will always leave our loved ones with loving words? All of this is God’s work, helping to awaken our appreciation of God’s boundless love for each one of us. It is said ‘where you are, you will find God’. The more we experience God’s love within our families, the more ‘holy families’ there will be.

SCHOOL NEWS



Dear Parishioner,

Queen of All Saints School is grateful to you for supporting the advancement of Catholic school education. I am writing about a unique opportunity for Archdiocese of Chicago Catholic schools. The State of Illinois created a tax credit scholarship program through the “Invest in Kids” Act that is mutually beneficial to students and donors. It provides a 75 percent Illinois State income tax credit to individuals who contribute money to fund scholarships for students to attend private schools. Eligible students from low-income families in Illinois may use these scholarships to attend a non-public school of their choice, including the more than 200 Archdiocese of Chicago Catholic schools in Cook and Lake Counties.

To increase the funds available for scholarships next year, several donors have partnered with the scholarship granting organization Empower Illinois and the Archdiocese of Chicago to create a matching gift pool.

- Every dollar donated to this program through Empower Illinois between Dec. 1, 2019 and Feb. 29, 2020 and designated to a school operated by the Archdiocese of Chicago will be matched with two dollars from this pool (limitations apply). The program will end when all matching funds have been depleted or on Feb. 29, 2020, whichever comes first.
- A \$5,000 donation will have a tremendous impact. With the 75 percent tax credit you receive on the donation and this match, it will have a net cost to you of \$1,250 and will provide \$15,000 in scholarships for low-income families.
- After April 1, 2020, any matching gift program funds that are not awarded at a designated school will be reallocated to low-income students at schools with unmet demand.
- Donors who would like to receive the tax credit for their 2019 taxes should begin the process prior to Dec. 16, 2019 to ensure they have enough time to make their gift by Dec. 31, 2019.

We also want to share with you this message from Cardinal Blase J. Cupich, Archbishop of Chicago, regarding the importance of the tax credit scholarship program. Please visit <https://schools.archchicago.org/tax-credit-scholarships>

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.

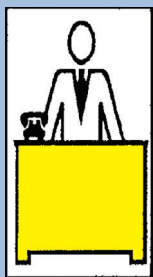
