

BAPTISM OF THE LORD

FROM FATHER SIMON



In the opening verses of the Book of Genesis we are told that the earth was formless and void, literally ‘total chaos’, and the Spirit of the Lord hovered over the waters. God divided the cosmic sea to create a three-tiered universe: the sea, the heavens and the earth. God brought order to the cosmic sea by gathering the waters covering the entire face of the earth into seas, and established their boundaries rooting the earth in the primal sea. Confining the sea itself is depicted in Genesis as an aspect of divine power. In the book of Exodus, God parts the waters of the Sea of Reeds to redeem Israel and fill them with awe and holy fear.

The image of Jesus emerging from the waters of the Jordan after his baptism is intended to remind us of God’s dominion over chaos, death and destruction. The picture of the Holy Spirit descending from Heaven like a dove echoes the book of Genesis, which tells of the Holy Spirit “hovering” over the tumultuous, primal sea.

Similarly, the story of Jesus’ baptism is told with all the trappings of a divine epiphany and echoes with references to both Genesis and Exodus. Jesus parts the waters, the Holy Spirit hovers, and a voice from Heaven proclaims Jesus “my beloved Son.” The story of Jesus’ baptism, therefore, stands as the link between the stories of God’s saving acts in the Old Testament beginning with creation itself, and the advent of a new creation in the life and ministry of Jesus. Through the Incarnation, the scriptures emphasize that heaven and earth are reunited, and a new relationship with God is established. As we emerge from the season of Christmas and enter the liturgical season of ‘ordinary’ time let us meditate afresh upon how our world has been irreparably changed by the coming of God in Jesus of Nazareth. Let us be mindful that he who brought order to the primal chaos will, if we allow God, bring order to the uncertainty and chaos of our everyday ‘ordinary’ lives.

As we enter into the season of Ordinary Time, allow me to express, on your behalf, a word of gratitude to the many who made it possible for us to celebrate the beauty and the mystery of the Incarnation.

To the members of the Men’s Club who braved the cold to set up and take down the Nativity scene that many have captured on their digital devices, may it be imprinted on our hearts...

To Mary Asnis and Gia DeCarlo and their team of helpers who decorated the inside of the basilica enhancing the beauty of our worship space...

To the ushers, sacristans, altar servers, lectors and eucharistic ministers for helping us celebrate the mysteries in a dignified and reverent manner...

To Dr. Ken Sotak, Paul Scavone, the instrumentalists, the Basilica Choir and our Children’s Christmas Choir, for giving us a taste of heavenly music...

To our maintenance staff, who put up the lights outside, made sure the basilica and its facilities were ready for the celebrations...

To all others who in one way or another contributed their time and talent to enhance our experience of Christmas at the basilica...

QAS third-grade students got more than a basic music lesson during a recent class. At the beginning of class students were able to listen to a live performance of J.S. Bach's Toccata and Fugue in D Minor. This particular piece of music was written for the pipe organ. The students were very interested in the pipe organ and asked a lot of questions.

Fortunately, Queen of All Saints Basilica is home to an extraordinary pipe organ containing over 3,300 pipes, which gave music teacher Sheila Chovanec an idea. Mrs. Chovanec arranged a tour of the organ with QAS Music Director Ken Sotak. Dr. Sotak gave the students a tour of the organ and the rooms where the biggest pipes and wind machine are located. Dear Parishioner,

Queen of All Saints School is grateful to you for supporting the advancement of Catholic school education. I am writing about a unique opportunity for Archdiocese of Chicago Catholic schools. The State of Illinois created a tax credit scholarship program through the “Invest in Kids” Act that is mutually beneficial to students and donors. It provides a 75 percent Illinois State income tax credit to individuals who contribute money to fund scholarships for students to attend private schools. Eligible students from low-income families in Illinois may use these scholarships to attend a non-public school of their choice, including the more than 200 Archdiocese of Chicago Catholic schools in Cook and Lake Counties.

To increase the funds available for scholarships next year, several donors have partnered with the scholarship granting organization Empower Illinois and the Archdiocese of Chicago to create a matching gift pool.

- Every dollar donated to this program through Empower Illinois between Dec. 1, 2019 and Feb. 29, 2020 and designated to a school operated by the Archdiocese of Chicago will be matched with two dollars from this pool (limitations apply). The program will end when all matching funds have been depleted or on Feb. 29, 2020, whichever comes first.
- A \$5,000 donation will have a tremendous impact. With the 75 percent tax credit you receive on the donation and this match, it will have a net cost to you of \$1,250 and will provide \$15,000 in scholarships for low-income families.
- After April 1, 2020, any matching gift program funds that are not awarded at a designated school will be reallocated to low-income students at schools with unmet demand.
- Donors who would like to receive the tax credit for their 2019 taxes should begin the process prior to Dec. 16, 2019 to ensure they have enough time to make their gift by Dec. 31, 2019.

We also want to share with you this message from Cardinal Blase J. Cupich, Archbishop of Chicago, regarding the importance of the tax credit scholarship program. Please visit <https://schools.archchicago.org/tax-credit-scholarships>

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated at 1:30pm two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.


