



Candlemas Sunday



Sunday, February 2nd, is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, traditionally known as Candlemas Day. The tradition of Candlemas Day represents the entry of Christ, the light of the world, into the temple of Jerusalem. In celebration of this feast, everyone is invited to bring candles from home to be blessed at Mass, the weekend of February 1st and 2nd.

While it is customary for Christians in some countries to remove their Christmas decorations on Twelfth Night (Epiphany Eve), historically others remove them on Candlemas. On Candlemas, many Christians, notably Anglicans, Methodists, Lutherans, Orthodox and Roman Catholics bring their candles to their local church, where they are blessed and then used for the rest of the year. Bringing the candle into the home is a sign that Christ is with you in your everyday life.



Stewardship - A Time to Reconsider Our Commitments

It's January of a new year. Christmas and all its attractions (both spiritual and material) are behind us. Perhaps now it's time to review our commitments to God and to each other, using the traditional stewardship terms of **time** (such as an hour a week to attend Mass), **talent** (helping those in our community who are in need) and **treasure** (giving back some of the material gifts we have been blessed to receive). Let's think in these terms:

Intentional - a well thought-out, deliberate and honest discussion with ourselves to thank God for all of his blessings by returning to him a portion of the time, talent, and treasure given to us

Planned - using this time of the year for our family to make stewardship of time and talent a regular part of our lifestyle and stewardship of treasure a part of our budget.

Proportionate - make a firm decision to give a certain percentage of our time and our income to our parish and to other charities.



The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated at 1:30pm two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
