FROM FATHER SIMON



Under normal circumstances, in the days following Easter, the rectory would be swarmed by volunteers for the United Parish Program. There would be meetings, poring over plans and working on little details for a spectacular evening under the tent in the shadow of the basilica.

However, given the current situation, after a prolonged discussion with Laura Herbert, Laurie Vlasic the chairs and Juan Cabrales, Barbara Graham, Cariane Keane and Louise Locke, the co-chairs, we have decided to postpone our May 15 gala to a late summer date. We will continue to communicate information regarding this change to our community. We can't wait to celebrate “under the stars” together.

While we continue to monitor the situation, each of the committees are continuing to plan to move forward soliciting ads, sponsorships and banners. Our primary focus now is the raffle which we have revamped this year. Each ticket costs just thirty dollars and the prize money has increased. In addition, we have three more early bird drawings for five hundred dollars each. If you buy a block of ten tickets, you will be entered for a special prize of one thousand dollars. Our goal is to sell 3,500 tickets. If we achieve our goal, another prize of \$2,500 will be added and if we do better and sell 110% of our goal a fifth prize of \$2,500 dollars will be added. With so many opportunities to win, it should be hard to resist buying your tickets now!!

I want to acknowledge the contributions of Bernie Henry, our videographer, Ken Sotak and the choir for providing live and previously recorded music so that our celebrations have the same solemnity as we would normally have, Paul, Mary Asnis and Gia DiCarlo for decorating the sanctuary and the outside to make the environment festive. 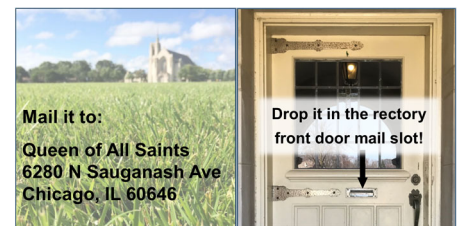
- If you currently have an active GiveCentral account, you may use the cell phone registered to your account to give by text.

 - To make a Sunday donation send a text with the keyword “*sundayqas*” followed by an amount (e.g., to **make a \$100 donation to Sunday collections, text: sundayqas 100**). To make an Easter donation text “easter” followed by the amount. Leave a space between the keyword and the amount.
 - If you do not have a GiveCentral account, you may still text the same way to the same number which will then return a link that will allow you to enter your contact and payment information for your donation.
- At this time, donations may only be made to Sunday and Easter using Text to Give.

know what we need.

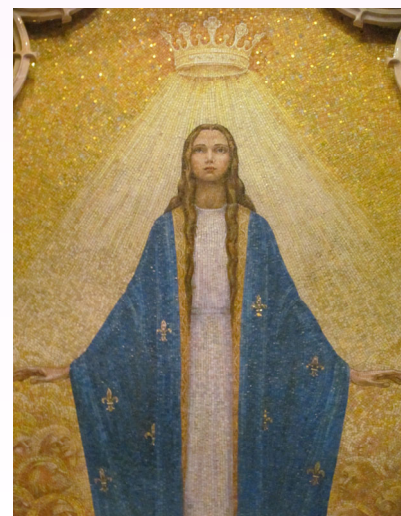
We are certain that you will provide, so that,

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Today was once called in Latin “Dominica in albis,” or “Sunday in White,” because the church was full of newly baptized Christians wearing their white baptismal garments. Another old title, best forgotten, is “Low Sunday.” There’s nothing low about this festive Sunday in Easter, the eighth day since the first “Alleluia” rang out. In Christian tradition, the number eight is a symbol of fulfillment, transition, breaking through the seven-day rhythm of life to a new way of being. That is why many baptismal fonts have eight sides. The greatest feasts of our calendar are always extended for eight days, called an “octave.” In a way, this means that this first week of Easter is really considered to be one great day. This octave day of Easter sees the best features of Easter still vibrant: joyful alleluias, lush spring flowers everywhere, sprinkling with water, and a lavish table where the Lord gives us himself as bread and wine.

For Orthodox Christians, today is the Easter feast, since their tradition requires that the Christian Passover cannot begin until the days of the Jewish Passover are ended.

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated at 1:30pm two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.

GET REAL! Those of us who flatter ourselves that we have a "realistic" view of the world may listen to the first reading today and say, "Get real!" when we hear Luke's account of the early, Elysian days of the Christian movement. All seems to be rosy, lots of wonders are performed, everyone shares selflessly, they eat together in "exultation," and the Lord added to their numbers. Well, who wouldn't be attracted to a group like this? From the wind that swept through the upper room at Pentecost as the Spirit of God blew over the face of the waters in Genesis, and the fire that appeared over each disciple as the light appeared at the dawn of creation, Luke's intent in Acts is to show a new creation, a restoration of creation's original goodness through the working of the Holy Spirit. It is the Spirit who continues to make us into the Body of Christ. We may occasionally, like Thomas in the Gospel, say, "Get real!" but our ultimate reality in the Spirit is to work continually to make our Christian community a new creation, one in which others will find God's joy and beauty.

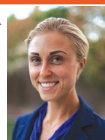
