

# FROM FATHER SIMON



Over the last week, a lot has happened. We find ourselves encumbered by the global pandemic COVID-19 and the ugly reality of racism. On the other hand, we have something good to look forward to – to gather once again as a community of faith and celebrate the sacraments in our basilica.

The parish reopening leadership team has pored over the directives from the Archdiocese of Chicago and come up with a plan that needs to be approved by the Archdiocese.

## **Here are some details of the plan**

We will open on Saturday June 6, 2020 for the sacrament of reconciliation (confessions) from 8:30am to 10am. Penitents should wear a mask at all times and follow the instructions of the ushers.

We will open the basilica for private prayer on Sunday June 7, 2020 from 9am to 1pm. There is a limit of 10 persons in the basilica at any given time. Please wear a mask the entire time, limit your prayer time to 20 minutes and follow the instructions of the ushers.

## **Opening for Masses**

As we prepare and plan for Masses there are requirements, as per the directives of the Archdiocese, that we must follow. This will impact the schedule and how we move forward. I ask for your patience and cooperation in this regard.

The Archdiocese requires that the church be cleaned, disinfected and sanitized before every Mass. After discussion, we realize that it will take us 45 minutes to complete this process. We will let you know through email and the parish website the schedule on Monday, June 8, 2020.

There is a limit for the number of people who can gather in the basilica at any one time. At present the limit for attendance at Mass is 15 – 20 percent of our capacity. All attending must observe social distancing practices.

The Archdiocese also mandates a reservation system for weekend Masses. Our registration system will be in place before our first Sunday Masses, which hopefully will take place on the weekend of June 13 and 14.

Please understand that we are a large parish community that attracts a lot of people from other parishes. Some parishes have a reservation system in which anyone can sign-in. Not to sound selfish or unwelcoming, our priority is to give our parishioners the first choice. If you are receiving the weekly email, we will send you the link to make your reservation. If we do not have your email, this would be a good time to send your email to [qasoffice@qasparish.org](mailto:qasoffice@qasparish.org). For those who do not have access to the internet, we have allotted a certain percentage of seats available for phone reservations. Details regarding this will be available on the website and on the parish voicemail.

The parish offices will be open from 9am to 1pm, Monday through Friday. Although we would love to have a personal face-to-face interaction with you, at this time we encourage you to use the phone or email to communicate your needs and we will do our best to attend to them.

I know this is a lot of information and more will be coming. In the meantime, I want to draw your attention to Cardinal Cupich's Statement on the current unrest in our city and nation.

# FROM CARDINAL CUPICH

## STATEMENT OF CARDINAL BLASE J. CUPICH, ARCHBISHOP OF CHICAGO, ON THE MURDER OF GEORGE FLOYD AND ITS AFTERMATH

Sunday, May 31, 2020

The past nights I have watched in great personal pain as the pent-up anger of our people caught fire across our country. I saw the city where I was born, the cities where I have lived, the city I pastor now, catch embers from the city where I was educated and burn. Was I horrified at the violence? Yes. But was I surprised? No.

As the saying goes, if you're not outraged, you're not paying attention. What did we expect when we learned that in Minneapolis, a city often hailed as a model of inclusivity, the price of a black life is a counterfeit twenty-dollar bill? When we added another name to the list of those murdered for being black or for caring about the marginalized?

I will not pretend to speak with any authority about the challenges people of color experience in our society. I do not share the fear they put on when they and their children leave their homes every day. I do not know what it means to be "other." But I know there is a way to fix it. And the fix begins when we stop talking about the proportionality of "their" response and start talking about the proportionality of "ours." Surely a nation that could put a man in space, his safety assured by the brilliance of black women, can create a fair legal system, equitable education and employment opportunities and ready access to health care. Laws do not solve problems, but they create a system where racism in all its forms is punished and playing fields are leveled.

The COVID-19 pandemic has been called a great equalizer. It has been even more a great revealer of societal cancers as deadly as the virus. As others have pointed out, health insecurity kills, and poverty is poison. We can and must make a society that views the soaring of a child's potential with more joy than the soaring of a rocket.

I stand ready to join religious, civic, labor and business leaders in coming together to launch a new effort to bring about recovery and reconciliation in our city. We do not need a study of the causes and effects. Those answers can be found on the shelves of government offices and academic institutions across our burning nation. No, we need to take up the hard work of healing the deep wound that has afflicted our people since the first slave ships docked on this continent. And we need to start today.

## NEW TAX DEDUCTION

There is a new tax deduction for charitable contributions even if you take the standard deduction. The CARES Act (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act) provides a new tax deduction for those who do not itemize. Starting in 2020, charitable donations can be deducted from taxable income up to \$300 per person, or \$600 for joint filers.

Registration for Religious Education 2020-2021 is now open!

The QASRE program begins at kindergarten and goes through eighth grade. Our program focuses on building a relationship with Christ as your children grow in their discipleship.

Students wanting to participate in the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation must attend a minimum of two years of Religious Education as per the archdiocesan requirement. First Reconciliation and Communion preparation begins at 1st grade. Confirmation preparation begins at 7th grade.



## Stewardship in Time of COVID-19 A Path to Reopening Volunteers Needed!

Here is what our parish campus looked like in 1955, when nearly all our buildings had been erected. Something very essential is missing - you!



We need volunteers to assist with our parish reopening plan who are not part of a “vulnerable population” (that is, not over the age of 65, no underlying medical condition such as diabetes or lung disease, undergoing cancer treatment, etc.).

We need volunteers to:

- manage the flow of worshipers as they enter and exit the church as well as the reception of Holy Communion
- make sure attendees use hand sanitizer upon entering the church and before receiving Communion
- see that all are wearing a mask, and are reminded not to enter if ill
- direct people to appropriate seating and waiting areas, etc.
- help with cleaning, if required.

## The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated at 1:30pm two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

## The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

## Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.




