PLEASE WELCOME OUR NEW ASSOCIATE PASTOR FR. JESUDAS GUDIME



Father Jesudas Gudime was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Kadapa, India in 1997. Between 1997 – 2003 Father Gudime served the church of Kadapa as associate pastor of St. Mary’s Cathedral, assistant director of Sacred Heart Pastoral Centre and pastor of Sacred Heart Church. In 2003, Fr. Jesudas was sent to the Philippines to attend the East Asian Pastoral Institute (EAPI) in Quezon City, Manila, from which he received a certificate and diploma for his participation in an intensive program of study on the topic of “Preaching the Word”.

Upon his return to India, Fr. Jesudas was appointed Director of Evangelization for his region with a goal of establishing “Small Christian Communities” in an effort to help the local church become more self-reliant. Afterward, he served for three years as principal of Infant Jesus School and then as pastor of Our Lady of Holy Rosary Church, for which he was entrusted with the special task of building a new parish church, which he carried out with utmost care and diligence. The newly built church in honor of our Blessed Mother stands as an attraction to Christians and non-Christians alike.

In 2014, Fr. Jesudas moved on from Our Lady of Holy Rosary parish to serve a smaller parish so that he could focus on counselling skills and his studies in counselling and psychotherapy at Fountain College, Krishnagiri, India. On a personal note, Father Gudime’s father Samuel passed away in 2013 at the age of 80, and his mother Showramma passed away in 2018, also at the age of 80. His parents’ death came as a big shock to him as he loved them very much.

In 2019, his bishop sent Father Jesudas to minister in the United States. The Archdiocese of Chicago appointed him associate pastor at St. John of the Cross. Today, Father Jesudas is especially excited to have been appointed to serve as associate pastor for the parish of Queen of All Saints Basilica.

NEW TAX DEDUCTION

There is a new tax deduction for charitable contributions even if you take the standard deduction. The CARES Act (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act) provides a new tax deduction for those who do not itemize. Starting in 2020, charitable donations can be deducted from taxable income up to \$300 per person, or \$600 for joint filers. RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION


Registration for Religious Education 2020-2021 is now open!

The QASRE program begins at kindergarten and goes through eighth grade. Our program focuses on building a relationship with Christ as your children grow in their discipleship.

Students wanting to participate in the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation must attend a minimum of two years of Religious Education as per the archdiocesan requirement. First Reconciliation and Communion preparation begins at 1st grade. Confirmation preparation begins at 7th grade.

IMMIGRATION RESOURCES FROM THE SOCIAL JUSTICE MINISTRY

The recent US Supreme Court's decision on Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) put the spotlight on the DACA program, and more broadly, the issue of immigration.



What is DACA? Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) is a United States immigration policy introduced in 2012 by President Barack Obama that allows some individuals who were brought to the US as children under the age of 16, have clean criminal records, and lack any lawful immigration status to receive a renewable two-year period of deferred action from deportation and become eligible for a work permit. DACA does not provide a path to citizenship. DACA recipients are often nicknamed “Dreamers”. [US Citizenship & Immigration Services \(USCIS\) data](#) indicates the US has 788,000 approved DACA recipients. (COVID-19 related factoid: [American Medical Association estimates the 27,000 DACA recipients working in US healthcare](#) will touch the lives of over 5 million patients over the course of their careers.)

What was the US Supreme Court's Decision? The court, in a 5-4 opinion written by Chief Justice John Roberts, said the administration acted arbitrarily when it moved to end the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals program, failing to offer adequate reasons for doing so. Significantly, the Supreme Court did not rule on the legality of the DACA program, nor did it resolve the immigration status of the

DACA recipients. As a result, per [Homeland Security's webpage on DACA](#), “Due to a federal court order, USCIS (US Citizenship & Immigration Services) has resumed accepting requests to renew a grant of deferred action under DACA. USCIS is not accepting requests from individuals who have never before been granted deferred action under DACA.”

PARISH WEBSITE

Go onto the parish website and click on “Mass Reservation.” Then click on signup labeled “here.” Signups for the weekend and following week are available every Wednesday.

PASSWORD

To sign up for a weekend Mass you will need to use a password. This password will be emailed every Wednesday before the weekend Masses. There is no password required for weekday Masses.

3

CHOOSING A MASS TIME

Look through the Mass times and check “sign up” under the Mass time you want to attend then select “submit and sign up” at the bottom of the page.

4

MAKING A RESERVATION

Put your name, email, and phone number in the designated slots. Then elect “sign up now.”

If you have 1-4 people in your reservation, make one reservation. If you have 5-8 people in your reservation, make two reservations. Do not include people living outside of your household in your reservation.

CONGRATULATIONS

You have officially signed up to attend Mass. You will receive a reminder email two days before the date of your reservation.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

It's Independence Day week, and there is a link worth tracing between the Declaration of Independence and the language of liturgy. One of the signers of the Declaration on that July 4 long ago was Charles Carroll, probably the wealthiest man in the colonies and one of the few Catholics on the political scene. As a flourish to his signature, he sought to distinguish himself from other prominent citizens bearing the same name by penning "Charles Carroll of Carrolltown"—a defiant "come and get me if you dare" postscript aimed at the British.

Carroll's brother John was a priest and patriot who in 1789 was given the task of organizing the Catholic Church in this country. By 1791 he had assembled a synod, or assembly of delegates, to launch that task formally. Archbishop Carroll wanted to gain acceptance of our faith by American people who mistrusted our customs and could not comprehend our liturgy. He made the amazing proposal to Rome that our liturgy should be prayed not in Latin, but in the vernacular, English. His wish was denied, but one hundred sixty years later, his deep desire helped the American bishops and scholars at the Second Vatican Council to win the vote in favor of the vernacular not just for the United States, but for the Church throughout the world.

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.




