FROM FATHER SIMON



We had our customary plans to gather as a community under a massive tent on May 15, and then backup plans to gather as an open-air celebration in the parking lot later this summer, to ‘be grateful to the past, mindful of the present and hopeful for the future.’ Sadly, but not unexpectedly, those plans had to be cancelled. Since this is our one and only parish-wide fundraiser that supports the many ministries in the parish, the UPP leadership team is eager and working hard to find alternate ways to reach our goal of \$275,000.

The Raffle – helps us raise a little more than a third of our goal. To achieve this, we must sell 3,500 tickets. Right now, we are less than 1,000 away from this goal. If we reach our goal, we will add another cash prize of \$2,500. If you buy a block of ten tickets for just \$300, you will be eligible for an additional drawing with a prize of \$1,000. The winning tickets will be picked on August 20, 2020.

Sponsorships - Another major source of income has been the sponsorships. Please consider continuing to help us with your generous sponsorships.

FROM THE QAS SOCIAL JUSTICE MINISTRY: IMMIGRATION ACTION



The US Conference of Catholic Bishops Justice for Immigrants office has released a [DACA Action Alert](#) asking us to contact our senators regarding legislation (S. 874) on DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals) which would, among other things, give DACA recipients a pathway to citizenship. This bill is similar to House Resolution (H.R. 6) passed about a year ago. The bishops felt so strongly about this bill that they sent a letter to the Senate in support of it. This Action Alert was sent to us from the Immigration Ministry of the Office of Human Dignity and Solidarity of the Archdiocese of Chicago.

Social justice seeks the oft-repeated phrase from the Our Father: "thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven". Social justice initiatives seek to change our systems to be more just, especially for the poor and marginalized. But paradoxically, that change begins inside each of us with education and reflection to prayerfully seek to first understand the systems we are seeking to change, then acting for change.

SIGNING UP FOR MASS

QUEEN OF ALL SAINTS

1 PARISH WEBSITE

Go onto the parish website and click on "Mass Reservation." Then click on signup labeled "here." Sign ups for the weekend and following week are available every Wednesday.

2 PASSWORD

To sign up for a weekend Mass you will need to use a password. This password will be emailed every Wednesday before the weekend Masses. There is no password required for weekday Masses.

3 CHOOSING A MASS TIME

Look through the Mass times and check "sign up" under the Mass time you want to attend then select "submit and sign up" at the bottom of the page.

4 MAKING A RESERVATION

To attend the Mass, make one reservation (Quantity = 1) and in the white box, indicate the total number of people in your household that are attending. Please do not include people living outside of your household in your reservation.

Add your first, last name and email in the designated boxes and then click the "sign up now."

5 CONGRATULATIONS

You have officially signed up to attend Mass. You will receive a reminder email two days before the date of your reservation.



DRIVE-IN MASS

We are happy to announce that our Sunday 7 am Mass is scheduled as a “drive-in” Mass in our parking lot, weather and other logistics permitting. **This Mass has limited capacity and is especially designed for the more vulnerable members of our parish who are not comfortable attending Mass in the basilica due to age, mobility, immune status or other health issues.** Some tips to efficiently ensure the health of our fellow parishioners:

- Make a reservation for your car (one reservation per household) for the 7 am Sunday Mass. The on-line link to register will be sent on Wednesday. Everyone who attends this Mass must arrive in a car and remain inside their car for the duration of the Mass.
- The parking lot will open at 6:30 am and will close at 7:05 am – so that our celebration will not be disturbed by those arriving late.
- All cars will be parked facing west, and a temporary altar (**marked below in blue**) will be set at the west end of the parking lot on a short platform.
- Cars will be parked socially distant, similar to how the pews in the church are arranged - for each row, cars are to be parked in every other spot in the row, diagonally to the car in front of you (**marked below in red**).
- All cars are to enter the parking lot from the north end at Sauganash and Lemont Avenues (**marked below in green**). All cars are to exit the parking lot from the south end on to Keene (**marked below in purple**).
- The Mass will be broadcast on a low-power FM frequency which you can hear on your car radio. The frequency of our broadcast will be posted in the parking lot.
- Communion will be distributed through your open car window. Please use your own hand sanitizer before receiving Communion.
- Please do not park on Keene or Sauganash Avenues. It is unlikely that our radio transmission will reach you and Communion will not be distributed there.

We expect Mass to take less than 45 minutes.

STEWARSHIP 4 WAYS TO HELP

These are strange and difficult times. The stock market is near an all-time high, yet unemployment is at a level not seen since the Great Depression in the 1930s. This is an opportunity for those of us with the means to do so to step up and help our parish maintain the financial strength **to be present for every member at every stage of our lives, from the very young to the very old.**

- ***The Blue Envelope*** included in your bi-monthly envelope mailing.
- **A check** sent to the rectory made out to Queen of All Saints Parish, with a notation earmarking it for direct deposit to parish endowments.
- **A planned giving option**, such as a gift of appreciated securities, a Qualified Charitable Distribution from your IRA if you are at least 70 1/2 years old, or by including our parish in your estate planning. (Contact our business office for more information).

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated on Saturdays. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. Please contact the rectory for further details. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
