FROM FATHER SIMON



Deep within each of us there is a great desire, a longing for something more, for something beyond, for something better than the best. This longing could be for an answer to life's ultimate questions, for a job that offers us happiness and contentment, for the uncomfortable and painful present we find ourselves in to change, for the simple joy of being with a loved one. Beneath all of this is a longing for truth, goodness and beauty which we can find in God alone.

Such longing cannot be ignored, denied or demonized. It is that ache in the belly felt by every human person at some point in life and we should pay attention to it. In this week's gospel, when he knows it is Jesus walking on the water, Saint Peter calls out 'Lord, if it is you, bid me come to you on the water.' At Jesus' invitation, Peter jumps into the water and soon finds himself threatened by the waves and cries out 'Lord, save me.' Our longing for God is often threatened by our busy lives and denied by our doubts such that we find ourselves unable to call upon the Lord to save us.

These days, 110 of our recent eighth-grade graduates receive the sacrament of confirmation. I impress upon them the need to have a personal relationship with Jesus, a relationship that cannot be put on the back burner as other things clamor for our attention.

The gospel offers us hope that through prayer we can sustain this relationship with Jesus and satisfy our longing for God. The gospel passage begins with Jesus alone in prayer with our heavenly Father. It is a prayer of 'oneness', enveloped in God's loving embrace, where our many questions are set aside and the mind is still in the peaceful presence of the divine. Next is Peter's prayer 'Lord, save me.' It is a petitionary prayer. God knows how many needs, wants and desires we have, to which we can give voice through our prayers of petition. Finally, there is the prayer of praise when the disciples acknowledge 'Truly, this man is the Son of God.'

Our prayer can take any one, or all three, of these forms. What is most important is that we know and believe that through prayer we can nourish our longing for God.

SOCIAL JUSTICE MINISTRY: DOMESTIC VIOLENCE DURING COVID-19

What do you do when “Stay At Home” is not safe?
Domestic violence surges during pandemic COVID-19 have made life more dangerous for many already at risk. Financial crises, home confinement and pro-



longed stress have increased the frequency and intensity of domestic violence. The Illinois Domestic Violence Hotline has reported that calls for help increased 50%. Nationwide Domestic Violence 911 emergency calls are estimated to have increased 10%-30%. Those caus-

ing harm to their partners are under greater stress during the pandemic. Their behavior of power and control is exacerbated because social contacts and movement of both spouses are severely restricted. Victims lack freedom to talk to friends or confidants. Sadly, while children are also at increased risk, statistics of child abuse reflect that children who are out of school have less opportunity to seek help.

If you know or suspect someone is a victim, please check on them! If they are in immediate need, help them call 911 or the National Domestic Violence 24-Hour Hotline at 800-799-7233 (800-799-SAFE) or visit thehotline.org.

SIGNING UP FOR MASS

QUEEN OF ALL SAINTS

1 PARISH WEBSITE

Go onto the parish website and click on “Mass Reservation.” Then click on signup labeled “here.” Sign ups for the weekend and following week are available every Wednesday.

2 PASSWORD

To sign up for a weekend Mass you will need to use a password. This password will be emailed every Wednesday before the weekend Masses. There is no password required for weekday Masses.

3 CHOOSING A MASS TIME

Look through the Mass times and check “sign up” under the Mass time you want to attend then select “submit and sign up” at the bottom of the page.

4 MAKING A RESERVATION

To attend the Mass, make one reservation (Quantity = 1) and in the white box, indicate the total number of people in your household that are attending. Please do not include people living outside of your household in your reservation.

Add your first, last name and email in the designated boxes and then click the “sign up now.”

5 CONGRATULATIONS

You have officially signed up to attend Mass. You will receive a reminder email two days before the date of your reservation.

SIGNING UP ON GIVECENTRAL

- Go to qasparish.org and click on the GiveCentral icon on the left side of your screen
- On the GiveCentral site (shown here to the right), click on “Sunday Offering” or whatever category to which you wish to contribute
- It will take you to “Make A Contribution”
- Enter an amount, choose frequency, if this will be ongoing or custom
- Click Add to my “Gift Basket”
- You will see the message “successfully added”
- Click “Check Out” then continue
- Click either “Complete Profile” or “Give as Guest”
- You will be prompted to enter your name, address and payment option. Please fill in accordingly
- Check “I Accept The User Policy” box
- Click “Confirm Gift”
- You will then see a pop-up box confirming your gift



TEXT TO GIVE

- If you currently have an active GiveCentral account, you may use the cell phone registered to your account to give by text.
- The phone number to give by text is 773-661-4683.
- To make a Sunday donation send a text with the keyword “*sundayqas*” followed by an amount (**e.g., to make a \$100 donation to Sunday collections, text: sundayqas 100**). To make an Easter donation text “easter” followed by the amount. Leave a space between the keyword and the amount.
- If you do not have a GiveCentral account, you may still text the same way to the same number which will then return a link that will allow you to enter your contact and payment information for your donation.

At this time, donations may only be made to Sunday and Easter using Text to Give.

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated on Saturdays. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. Please contact the rectory for further details. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.




