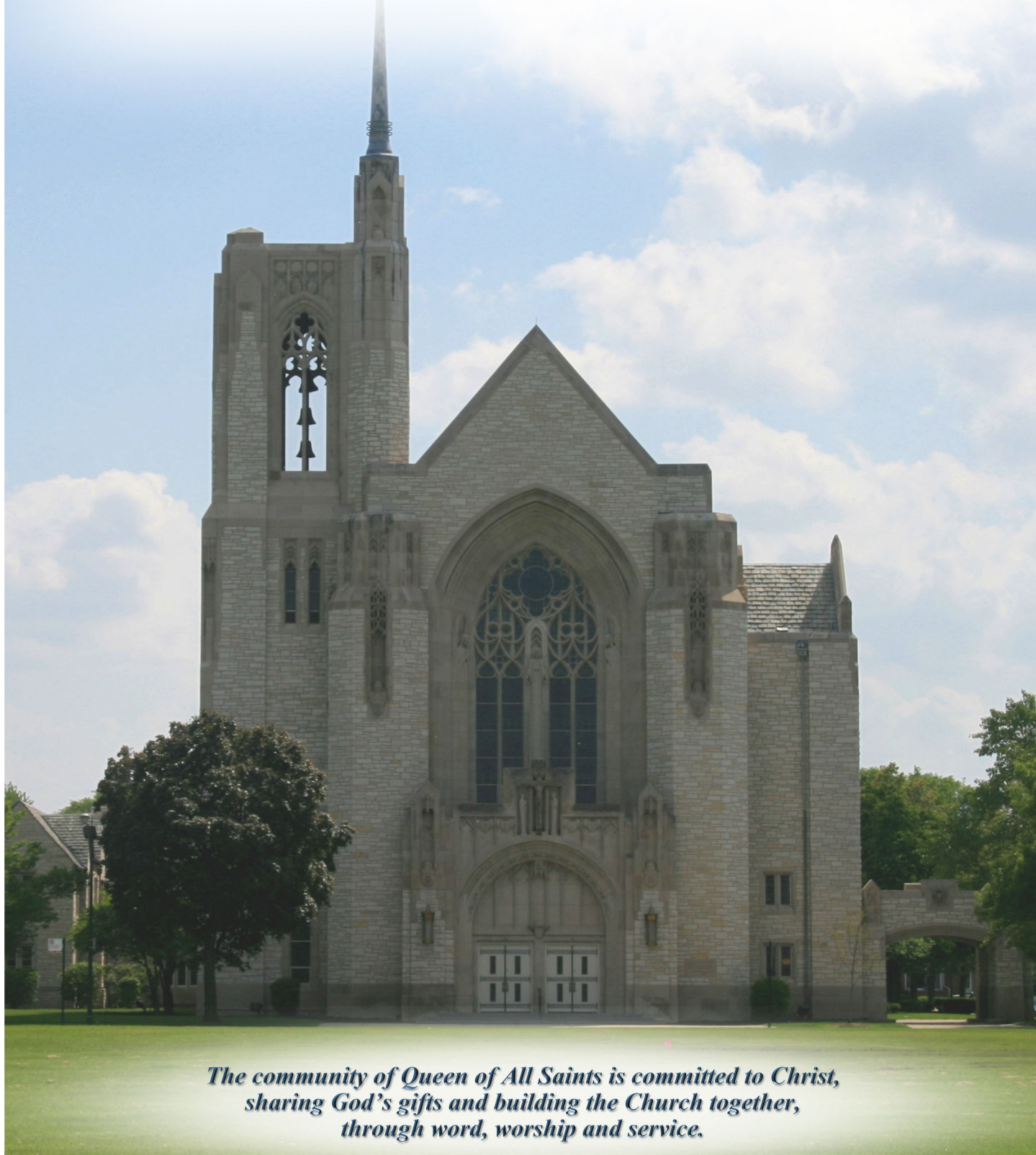

FROM FATHER SIMON



For a couple of months, the invitations to our United Parish Program that were ready and labelled to be sent out, sat on the table in the basement of the rectory. Our plans had to change due to the current crisis. The UPP leadership team have ‘manufactured’ creative ways to help us reach our goal of raising \$275,000. That’s a lot of money, but we can do it if we have the help and support of every single family in the parish. An online donation is one way you can help us in this effort.

The UPP, the United Parish Program, is our one and only fundraiser. The UPP aims to bring together the many and varied organizations in the parish to work as one toward a common goal, which is to build up the Body of Christ and to care for and support the sacramental, educational and ministerial needs of our members. It is therefore vital that every member of the parish community participates in this united endeavor. Here are some of the ways you can participate:

- **Donate the cost of the tickets to the dinner dance** you planned to attend, which would have been \$125 per person.
- **Purchase Raffle Tickets.** The Raffle helps us raise a little more than a third of our goal. To achieve this, we must sell 3,500 tickets. Right now, we are less than 370 tickets away from this goal. If we reach our goal, we will add another cash prize of \$2,500. If you buy a block of ten tickets for just \$300, you will be eligible for an additional drawing with a prize of \$1,000. The winning tickets will be picked on August 20, 2020.
- **Consider a Sponsorship.** Sponsorships are another major source of income. Please consider continuing to help us with your generous sponsorships.
- **Take part in the Wine Pull** – We have twenty-two bottles of wine left to be sold. Purchase a bottle for \$100 and become eligible to win a cash prize of \$2000. Only 100 bottles will be sold!
- **Place a bid in the ‘Silent Auction.’** We have several exciting offers for you to bid on through our silent auction which opens on August 17, 2020 and concludes on August 20, 2020. 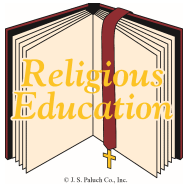

The QASRE program begins at kindergarten and goes through eighth grade. Our program focuses on building a relationship with Christ as your children grow in their discipleship.

Students wanting to participate in the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation must attend a minimum of two years of Religious Education as per the archdiocesan requirement. First Reconciliation and Communion preparation begins at 1st grade. Confirmation preparation begins at 7th grade.

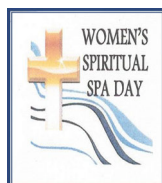
CATECHISTS NEEDED FOR RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

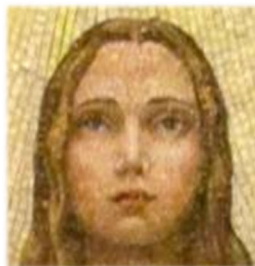

The Sacrament of Baptism

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated on Saturdays. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. Please contact the rectory for further details. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.

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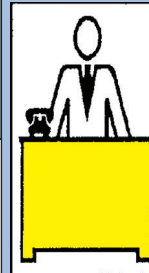


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
