# FROM FATHER SIMON



By the time you read this, Queen of All Saints School will have had students in school for eight days. It shouldn't come as a surprise that we are grateful to God for each day the kids are in school in these challenging times. I am grateful to our principal Emily Carlson, along with her teaching staff, members of the parish staff, maintenance crew and parents that are part of the reopening team.

Our current enrollment stands at 553 students with 67 students opting to e-learn for the first two weeks. The students are very conscious of their responsibility to wear masks, keep their social distance and respect the obligation to care for one another. This is the most Christian thing to do in these circumstances. I am proud that as a Catholic school we are able to create this sense of awareness and responsibility within our community. Thank you for observing these necessary precautions that are in place following the guidelines of the Archdiocese Office of Catholic Schools (OCS), as we continue our lives in the reality that surrounds us. While we have done all that is required, and even more, to ensure the safety of our children and teachers, there will still be many things that we will have to adapt to as we learn 'on the fly' the ever-changing reality of dealing with the unknowns.

**Masses at the basilica:** It is about ten weeks since we reopened the basilica for liturgical services. We altered our Mass schedule a bit to accommodate the time needed to clean between Masses. These past ten weeks gave us a chance to evaluate our reservation and check-in process, cleaning routines, Mass attendance and timings.

I am happy to report that the Sunday Mass at 7 am in the parking lot is a huge success. The number of cars we had over the last four weeks has steadily increased. Last Sunday we had 80 cars, several with three or more individuals, in our parking lot for Mass. Thank you to all the volunteers who help set up, check in cars, direct cars to parking spaces and tear down. We will continue to celebrate Mass in the parking lot until the end of October, weather permitting.

The Saturday 5 pm and Sunday 9 and 11 am Masses draw the largest number of people. However, the same cannot be said of the 1 pm Mass on Sunday. Most of those attending the 1 pm Mass said it was too late in the day. We listened. Beginning the first Sunday in October, the current 1 pm Mass will be moved up to 12:30 pm. At this time we are also taking a look at how in light of social distancing, we can provide an opportunity for the maximum number of people to attend Mass for the holidays. Masses in the basilica are an unequaled experience, whether at Christmas or throughout the year.

I also want to remind you that every week we livestream our Saturday 5 pm and Sunday 9 am Masses beginning with prelude music 15 minutes before the scheduled time to help you prepare for celebration of the Eucharist. You can log in to the parish website [qasparish.org](http://qasparish.org) and click on the livestream icon to view the Mass live. If you prefer, a recording of the same Mass is made available shortly after the end of Mass and can be watched at a later time that is more convenient for you.

Hope to see you at Mass or be seen on screen!






## FACA NOVENA TO SAN LORENZO RUIZ

## A MESSAGE FROM QAS SOCIAL JUSTICE MINISTRY

Our Catholic faith strongly encourages us to vote and actively participate politically. But knowing how to participate can be challenging given our incredibly polarized national discourse. The US Bishops, while offering neither an easy answer nor voting recommendations, have provided two thoughtful articles.



The first is a summary of the US Bishops' Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship. Here are a few key quotes from the first article:

- The Church cannot and must not remain on the sidelines in the fight for justice. - Pope Francis
- In the Catholic tradition, responsible citizenship is a virtue, and participation in political life is a moral obligation.
- Rightly understood, this ethic does not treat all issues as morally equivalent; nor does it reduce Catholic teaching to one or two issues.
- Catholic voters should use Catholic teaching to examine candidates' positions on issues and should consider candidates' integrity, philosophy and performance. It is important for all citizens "to see beyond party politics, to analyze campaign rhetoric critically, and to choose their political leaders according to principle, not party affiliation or mere self-interest."
- Conclusion: In light of Catholic teaching, the bishops vigorously repeat their call for a renewed politics that focuses on moral principles, the promotion of human life and dignity, and the pursuit of the common good. Political participation in this spirit reflects not only the social teaching of our Church but the best traditions of our nation.

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated on Saturdays. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. Please contact the rectory for further details. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

## The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

## Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
