FROM FATHER SIMON



Advent preparations and the anticipation of the joyous feast of Christmas is in full swing. With Cyber Monday extended to ‘cyber week’, shopping for deals and gifts are hitting a frenzy. The world is also moving at a hectic pace preparing for the distribution of the vaccine for COVID-19 and there is feverish anticipation and lobbying as to who should be the first to receive the vaccine.

Amidst this preparation and anticipation, we hear the familiar ‘voice of the one crying out in the wilderness: Prepare the way of the Lord.’ Most often, new beginnings in the scriptures take place in the uncertainty and insecurity of the desert – the journey of God’s chosen people through the desert, Isaiah’s vision for the returning exiles as they prepare to return to their homeland and later, Jesus himself withdrawing into the desert to prepare for his ministry.

People make the trek from the known comfort of their villages out into the desert to listen to John. Perhaps they journey to the desert for reasons similar to our own new ventures – not to be confirmed in what they already know about themselves, but to lose, even if only for the moment, their daily comforts and securities, so as to encounter something fresh and new. They take a risk in journeying to listen to John. Probably these people were dissatisfied with some aspects of their daily lives – whether personal, social, political, spiritual – and one day, they allow that dissatisfaction to lead them to something or someone new. They wander into the desert, let go of their daily, insulating routines and complacencies, and open themselves to the outrageous, yet somehow resonant and thus compelling, propositions of this lone voice in the desert. Who knows how long they waited, in that desert of uncertainty? What we do know is that one day, the Baptist, finally, proposed the new beginning they had so yearningly desired – ‘Look, there is the one we have been waiting for. Follow him.’

All of us – no matter who we are – enter this season to some degree incomplete and restless. This is great news! Beginnings demand restless hearts, the embrace of, the facing up to what has not yet been brought to life in us. That’s a start. But remember, John the Baptist called all people to repentance, to ask forgiveness and turn away from sin. John called them—and calls us—to orient our lives toward God. We are challenged to make changes—sometimes radical ones—to our lifestyle to get our priorities in line with God’s. In the midst of our restless preparations and feverish anticipation, we have to pay attention to what the Advent figures, Mary and John the Baptist have to offer us.



Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the sacrament of baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The sacrament of baptism for infants is celebrated on Saturdays. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A baptismal preparation class for the parents is required. Please contact the rectory for further details. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of Matrimony

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of the anointing of the sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
